Please sign up for an appointment if you haven't done so already.

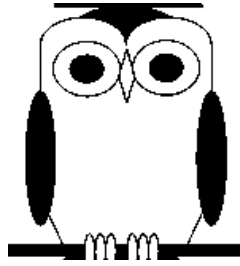
